1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 53-06.1-03 of
2 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the local permit prize limits.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 53-06.1-03 of the
5 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 a. An organization recognized as a public-spirited organization by the governing
7 body of a city or county may apply for a local permit to conduct only raffles, bingo,
8 or sports pools, or a charity local permit to conduct only raffles, bingo, sports
9 pools, paddlewheels, twenty-one, and poker. The organization or closely related
10 organizations as a whole may only award a primary prize that does not exceed
11 ~~six~~eight thousand dollars and total prizes of all games do not exceed ~~twelve~~forty
12 thousand dollars per year. These maximum prize amounts do not apply to raffles
13 conducted under chapter 20.1-08. The determination of what is a "public-spirited
14 organization" is within the sole discretion of the governing body. An organization
15 shall disclose on the application its intended use of the net income from the
16 gaming activity. A governing body may issue a permit for games to be held at
17 designated times and places.
