A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the
governor; to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-07 of the North Dakota Century
Code, relating to the Theodore Roosevelt presidential library and museum endowment fund; to
amend and reenact sections 54-07-04 and 54-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating
to salary of the governor and lieutenant governor; to provide a continuing appropriation; to
provide for a transfer; to authorize a loan; to provide an exemption; to provide for a report to the

7 legislative assembly; to provide for a budget section report; and to declare an emergency.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

9 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
10 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
11 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the office of the governor for the purpose of defraying
12 the expenses of the office of the governor, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending
13 June 30, 2021, as follows:

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1 SECTION 2. GOVERNOR'S OFFICE ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET 2 - REPORT TO SIXTY-SEVENTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the 3 one-time funding items approved by the sixty-fifth legislative assembly for the 2017-19 biennium 4 and the 2019-21 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act: 5 **One-Time Funding Description** 2017-19 <u>2019-21</u> 6 Transition costs \$0 \$65,000 7 Boards and commissions project 0 139,808 8 \$0 Total general fund \$204,808 9 The 2019-21 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 10 2021-23 biennium. The governor's office shall report to the appropriations committees of the 11 sixty-seventh legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium 12 beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. 13 SECTION 3. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION - GOVERNOR'S OFFICE -14 **BUDGET SECTION REPORT.** In addition to the amounts appropriated in section 1 of this Act. 15 there is appropriated to the governor's office, any additional income from federal or other funds 16 which may become available to the governor's office, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, 17 and ending June 30, 2021. Any funds received under this section must be used for the specific 18 purpose intended for the funds or transferred to the appropriate state agency or institution. 19 Upon the receipt of funds under this section, the governor's office shall provide a report to the 20 budget section regarding the source, amount, and purpose of the funds received. 21 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 54-07-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is 22 amended and reenacted as follows: 23 54-07-04. Salary of governor. 24 The annual salary of the governor is one hundred twenty-nine thousand ninety-oneone 25 hundred thirty-five thousand three hundred sixty-four dollars through June 30, 20162020, and 26 one hundred thirty-two thousand nine hundred sixty-fourone hundred thirty-eight thousand 27 seven hundred forty-eight dollars thereafter. 28 SECTION 5. A new section to chapter 54-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

29 and enacted as follows:

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1	Theodore Roosevelt presidential library and museum endowment fund - Continuing					
2	appropriation - Budget section report.					
3	There is created in the state treasury the Theodore Roosevelt presidential library and					
4	museum endowment fund. The governor may provide for the fund to be invested under the					
5	supervis	supervision of the board of university and school lands. The interest and earnings of the fund				
6	are appropriated to the governor on a continuing basis to pay interest expenses on a loan from					
7	the Bank of North Dakota and to provide grants pursuant to this section. The governor may					
8	provide grants to a private entity subject to the following:					
9	<u>1.</u>	The private entity has certified to the governor the entity has received the sum of one				
10		<u>hun</u>	dred million dollars in cash donations and binding pledged donations for the			
11		construction of a presidential library and museum in North Dakota and for grants to				
12		affected entities:				
13	<u>2.</u>	The governor has entered an agreement with the private entity in subsection 1 which				
14		includes the following provisions:				
15		<u>a.</u>	The grant funds will be spent only for operating and maintenance costs of the			
16			presidential library located in North Dakota;			
17		<u>b.</u>	Any unused grant funds will be returned to the state and deposited in the general			
18			fund if the presidential library has not been constructed within the period of time			
19			specified in the agreement or if the library ceases operations;			
20		<u>C.</u>	The private entity agrees to donate ten million dollars from the one hundred			
21			million dollars identified in subsection 1 to a higher education institution			
22			foundation in North Dakota for the purpose of creating an endowment to digitize			
23			documents relating to Theodore Roosevelt and for the creation of a Theodore			
24			Roosevelt conservation scholars program and related academic mission at a			
25			North Dakota higher education institution in collaboration with the private entity;			
26			and			
27		<u>d.</u>	The private entity agrees to donate three hundred thousand dollars to a city in			
28			North Dakota for prior costs incurred related to planning for a presidential library;			
29	<u>3.</u>	The governor provides a report to the budget section which includes copies of the				
30		documentation received for the certification provided in subsection 1; and				

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- 1 <u>4.</u> <u>The governor provides a report to the budget section within thirty days of applying for</u>
- 2 the loan authorized in section 8 of this Act which includes all completed loan

3 <u>application documents.</u>

4 SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 54-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is

- 5 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **54-08-03. Salary of lieutenant governor.**
- 7 The annual salary of the lieutenant governor is one hundred thousand two hundred-
- 8 fifteenone hundred five thousand two hundred eighty-five dollars through June 30, 20162020,
- 9 and one hundred three thousand two hundred twenty-one one hundred seven thousand nine
- 10 <u>hundred seventeen</u> dollars thereafter.

11 SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - TRANSFER. There is appropriated out of any moneys in 12 the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$15,000,000, or 13 so much of the sum as may be necessary, which the director of the office of management and 14 budget shall transfer to the Theodore Roosevelt presidential library and museum endowment 15 fund during the period beginning with the effective date of this Act, and ending June 30, 2019. 16 Of the funds appropriated in this section, \$9,800,000 is from unexpended funds previously 17 appropriated by the legislative assembly for grants related to the Theodore Roosevelt 18 presidential library. 19 SECTION 8. LOAN AUTHORIZATION. The governor may obtain a loan from the Bank of 20 North Dakota in an amount not to exceed \$35,000,000. The term of the loan may not exceed six 21 years and the interest rate must be set at the prevailing interest rate charged by the Bank of 22 North Dakota to governmental entities. The governor shall repay the loan authorized in this 23 section from funds appropriated by the legislative assembly. The governor shall deposit the 24 proceeds of the loan in the Theodore Roosevelt presidential library and museum endowment

- 25 fund.
- SECTION 9. EMERGENCY. Sections 5, 7, and 8 of this Act are declared to be an
 emergency measure.
