## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 50-06.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 9 and enacted as follows: 10 Service payments for elderly and disabled - Independent home and 11 community-based services care manager - Pilot program. 12 The department shall establish a pilot program for the provision of independent case 13 management services under the service payments for elderly and disabled program. 14 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 50-24.7 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 15 and enacted as follows: 16 Expanded service payments for elderly and disabled - Independent home and 17 community-based services care manager - Pilot program. 18 The department shall establish a pilot program for the provision of independent case 19 management services under the expanded service payments for elderly and disabled program. 20 SECTION 3.
