## **HOUSE BILL NO. 1248**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 37-14 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 57-38 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the creation of the veterans'
- 3 services fund and optional income tax contributions to the fund; and to provide a continuing
- 4 appropriation.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 37-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:
- 8 <u>Veterans' services fund Continuing appropriation.</u>
- There is created in the state treasury the veterans' services fund. The fund consists of
- 10 interest upon moneys in the fund and all moneys deposited in the fund pursuant to section 2 of
- 11 this Act. Moneys in the fund are appropriated to the administrative committee on veterans'
- 12 <u>affairs on a continuing basis for programs of benefit and service to veterans or their</u>
- 13 <u>dependents</u>.
- **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 57-38 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 15 and enacted as follows:
- 16 Optional contributions to veterans' services fund.
- An individual may designate on the tax return of that individual a contribution to the
- 18 veterans' services fund of any amount of one dollar or more to be added to tax liability or
- 19 <u>deducted from any refund that otherwise would be payable by or to the individual. The tax</u>
- 20 <u>commissioner shall notify taxpayers of this optional contribution on the individual state income</u>
- 21 <u>tax returns. The tax commissioner shall transfer the amount of optional contributions under this</u>
- 22 section to the state treasurer for deposit in the veterans' services fund for use as provided in
- 23 section 1 of this Act.
