## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - ETHICS COMMISSION AND
<b>LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY RESPONSIBILITIES.</b> During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative
management shall study the implementation and requirements of article XIV of the Constitution
of North Dakota concerning the transparency of funding sources, lobbyists, conflicts of interest
and related matters, the responsibilities of the legislative assembly and the ethics commission,
and potential issues under the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of North
Dakota. The members of the ethics commission must be invited to participate on the study
committee as nonvoting members. The study must include a review of existing laws and laws
enacted to implement article XIV and consideration of whether the civil and criminal sanctions
for violations of the constitutional provisions and the statutes are appropriate; whether
legislative action regarding article XIV is necessary or desirable; and an effective means to
educate public officials, lobbyists, and the public on the requirements of article XIV and other
laws regarding government ethics. The legislative management shall report its findings and
recommendations, together with any legislation necessary to implement the recommendations
to the sixty-seventh legislative assembly.
