## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds<u>and</u>.
<u>other income</u>, listed below, to the stated departments and institutions of the state of North
Dakota for the purpose of defraying their expenses for the period beginning with the effective
date of this Act, and ending June 30, 2019, as follows:

3	SECTION 2. SPECIAL FUNDS - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION		
4	FUND. The less special funds line item in subdivision 5 of section 1 of this Act includes		
5	\$1,586,061 from the environment and rangeland protection fund.		
6	SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - COST REIMBURSEMENTS - LOAN		
7	REPAYMENTS. It is the intent of the sixty-sixth legislative assembly that the attorney general		
8	seek reimbursement from the federal government for the costs of responding to unlawful activity		
9	associated with the construction of the Dakota access pipeline. It is further the intent of the		
10	sixty-sixth legislative assembly that these reimbursements be used to repay the Bank of North		
11	Dakota loans authorized by the emergency commission and the legislative assembly which		
12	were obtained to provide the funding necessary to respond to the unlawful activity associated		
13	with the construction of the Dakota access pipeline. It is further the intent of the sixty-sixth		
14	legislative assembly that the provisions of section 54-16-13 apply to the loans, except that		
15	emergency commission approval does not apply.		
16	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
