3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- <u>Law enforcement officers and firefighters Collective bargaining.</u>
- 6 1. Notwithstanding contrary provisions of law, an individual employed by a political
- 7 <u>subdivision as a law enforcement officer or as a paid full-time firefighter may form, join,</u>
- 8 and participate in the activities of a representative organization of the individual's
- 9 choosing for the purpose of representation on matters of employer-employee relations.
- 10 <u>Under this section, an employee may refuse to join or participate in the activities of a</u>
- 11 representative organization. This section does not apply to an elected law
- 12 <u>enforcement officer or volunteer firefighter.</u>
- 13 <u>2. A representative organization may represent a negotiating unit in matters of employee</u>
- relations with the governing body of a political subdivision employing law enforcement
- officers or paid full-time firefighters. Under this section, a law enforcement officer or
- paid full-time firefighter may present the individual's views directly to the employing
- 17 governing body.
- 18 3. The governing body of a political subdivision employing law enforcement officers or
- paid full-time firefighters and the representative organization or the organization's
- 20 representatives, if requested by either entity, shall meet at reasonable times and
- 21 negotiate in good faith regarding the terms and conditions of employment,
- 22 <u>employer-employee relations, formation of a contract, which may contain a provision</u>
- for binding arbitration, and the interpretation of an existing contract.

1 <u>4.</u> A law enforcement officer or paid full-time firefighter may not participate in a strike.
