- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 62.1-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a restriction on firearm buyback programs; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 62.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6 Firearm buyback program - Prohibited.

- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>As used in this section, "firearm buyback program" means a program to purchase</u>
- 8 privately owned firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition from private individuals or
- 9 organizations for the purpose of providing cash, gifts, or vouchers; or reducing the
- 10 <u>number of firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition owned by civilians; or permitting a</u>
- 11 <u>civilian to sell a firearm to the government without fear of prosecution. The term does</u>
- 12 <u>not include the purchase of firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition from a licensed</u>
- 13 <u>firearms dealer, or a program to purchase firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition for</u>
- 14 <u>law enforcement purposes.</u>
- 15 2. <u>A state agency, political subdivision, or any law enforcement agency of this state may</u>
 16 <u>not conduct a firearm buyback program or participate in the implementation,</u>
- 17 <u>administration, or operation of a firearm buyback program.</u>
- 183. A state agency, political subdivision, or any law enforcement agency of this state may19not expend any taxpayer dollars for the purpose of implementing, administering, or
- 20 <u>otherwise operating a firearm buyback program.</u>
- 21 <u>4.</u> <u>A violation of this section is a class A misdemeanor.</u>
