4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-34-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 **39-34-06.** Controlling authority.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, transportation network companies and transportation network company drivers are governed exclusively by this chapter, chapter 26.1-40.1, and any rules adopted consistent with this chapter and adopted by the insurance commissioner under chapter 26.1-40.1.
 - 2. A political subdivision may not impose a tax on, or require a license for, a transportation network company or a transportation network company driver or subject a transportation network company to the political subdivision's rate, entry, operational, or other requirements.
- This chapter may not be construed to limit the rights and powers of a commercial
 service airport under the jurisdiction of one or more political subdivisions to:
 - a. Regulate the operation of motor vehicles on the commercial service airport's premises in accordance with the rules, regulations, and policies adopted for the orderly use of the commercial service airport;
 - b. Establish, alter, and collect rates, fees, rental payments, or other charges for the use of the commercial service airport's services and facilities; and
 - c. Issue permits to, enter contracts with, or charge fees for a transportation network
 company's operations at a commercial service airport.

- 1 <u>4.</u> As used in this section, "commercial service airport" means a public airport that has at
- 2 <u>least two thousand five hundred passenger boardings each year and receives</u>
- 3 <u>scheduled passenger aircraft service.</u>
