## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 50-11.1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 50-11.1-08. Minimum standards Rules Inspection by a governmental unit.

- 1. Establish reasonable minimum standards for the operation of early childhood
  programs, self-declaration, and the registration of in-home providers. In appropriate
  circumstances and upon good cause shown, specific minimum standards may be
  substituted by alternate, equivalent standards, approved by the department. The rules
  must include fencing requirements for the premises of an early childhood program,
  self-declaration, and in-home provider.
  - Take such action and make reasonable rules for the regulation of early childhood services necessary to carry out the purposes of this chapter and entitle the state to receive aid from the federal government.
- 17 3. Authorize a governmental unit to:
  - Inspect the premises for which a license, self-declaration, or registration document is applied or issued under this chapter; and
  - b. Certify to the department that the premises of a program, holder of self-declaration, or registration document meets the requirements of this chapter and the minimum standards prescribed by the department.
