- 2 Century Code, relating to the health care professional student loan repayment program.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 43-12.3-06 of the North Dakota 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 1. The health council shall enter into a contract with a selected health care professional. 7 The health council shall agree to provide student loan repayments on behalf of the 8 selected health care professional subject to the requirements and limitations of this 9 section. 10 For a physician: a. 11 The loan repayment must be equal tomay not exceed twenty thousand 12 dollars per year, and may not exceed one hundred thousand dollars over 13 five years; and 14 (2) The matching funds must equal fifty percent of the amount required in 15 paragraph 1. 16 For a clinical psychologist: b. 17 The loan repayment must be equal tomay not exceed twelve thousand 18 dollars per year, and may not exceed sixty thousand dollars over five years; 19 and 20 (2) The matching funds must equal twenty-five percent of the amount required 21 in paragraph 1.
