- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 15 of section 19-24.1-01 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to debilitating medical conditions under the medical marijuana
- 3 program; to provide for a legislative management study; and to declare an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 15 of section 19-24.1-01 of the North Dakota 6 Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows: 7 "Debilitating medical condition" means one of the following: 15. 8 Cancer; a. 9 Positive status for human immunodeficiency virus: b. 10 Acquired immune deficiency syndrome; C. 11 Decompensated cirrhosis caused by hepatitis C; d. 12 Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis; e. 13 Posttraumatic stress disorder; f. 14 g. Agitation of Alzheimer's disease or related dementia; 15 Crohn's disease: h. 16 Fibromyalgia; i. 17 Spinal stenosis or chronic back pain, including neuropathy or damage to the į. 18 nervous tissue of the spinal cord with objective neurological indication of 19 intractable spasticity;

- m. Anorexia nervosa;

22	SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - MEDICAL MARIJUANA			
23	DEBILITATING MEDICAL CONDITIONS. During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative			
24	management shall consider studying the list of debilitating medical conditions under the medical			
25	marijuana program to determine the appropriateness of the list, including whether conditions			
26	should be added to or removed from the list. The legislative management shall report its			
27	findings and recommendations, together with any legislation necessary to implement the			
28	recommendations, to the sixty-seventh legislative assembly.
