- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-11-30 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the boundaries of property the state board of higher education may sell to fraternal
- 3 societies.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15-11-30 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 15-11-30. Sale of university land to fraternal societies.
- 8 The state board of higher education is hereby authorized to plat and replat, and after
- 9 suchthe platting, to sell and convey tracts of land lying within the east thirty-one acres [12.55]
- 10 hectares] of the northsouth half of the southwest guarter of section five four in township one
- 11 hundred fifty-one north, range fifty west of the fifth meridian, in Grand Forks County, North
- 12 Dakota, of suchthe size as may in the judgment of saidthe board be for the best interests of the
- 13 university, at such prices as may be determined by saidthe board to be adequate and proper in
- 14 the light of the cost thereof and of the improvements provided, to fraternities, sororities, and
- 15 institutional dormitory corporations for use solely and only as sites for fraternity houses, sorority
- 16 houses, dormitories, and like buildings, for the housing of students and faculty of the university
- 17 of North Dakota.
- All such deeds of conveyance must contain a provision for the reversion of the title theretoof
- 19 the land to the state of North Dakota should saidif the premises ever be used for purposes other
- 20 than those above provided.
- Conveyances of saidthe property must be executed in the name of the state of North
- 22 Dakota by the governor and attested by the secretary of state, under the great seal of the state
- 23 of North Dakota, upon resolution duly adopted by the state board of higher education and filed
- 24 with the secretary of state.
