## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - DATA BROKER INDUSTRY. During
5	the 2019-20 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying privacy practices in the
6	data broker industry to determine whether adequate safety measures exist to prevent fraud and
7	protect the identifying information of consumers. The study must include consultation with the
8	department of commerce and the attorney general, and an evaluation of the nature and sources
9	of the consumer information the data brokers collect, how data brokers use, maintain, and
10	disseminate the information, and the extent to which the data brokers allow consumers to
11	access and correct their information or to opt out of having their personal information sold. The
12	legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any
13	legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-seventh legislative
14	assembly.
