- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 15.1-19 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the prohibition on aiding and abetting sexual abuse; and to provide for
- 3 a penalty.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7 Prohibition on aiding and abetting sexual abuse.

- 8 <u>1.</u> The state educational agency, or local educational agency that receives federal funds
 9 under section 8546 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act [20 U.S.C. 7926]
- 10 shall prohibit any individual who is a school employee, contractor, or agent, or any
- 11 <u>state educational agency or local educational agency, from assisting a school</u>
- 12 <u>employee, contractor, or agent in obtaining a new job, apart from the routine</u>
- 13 transmission of administrative and personnel files, if the individual or agency knows, or-
- 14 has substantial probable cause to believe, that there is confirmation, or there is an
- 15 investigation underway based on a claim the school employee, contractor, or agent
- 16 <u>engaged in sexual misconduct regarding a minor or student in violation of law.</u>
- 17 <u>2.</u> <u>Subsection 1 does not apply if:</u>
- 18a.The information has been properly reported to a law enforcement agency with19jurisdiction over the alleged misconduct and any other authorities as required by20federal, state, or local law; and
- 21b. (1)The matter has been officially closed or the prosecutor or police with22jurisdiction over the alleged misconduct has investigated the allegations and23notified school officials that there is insufficient information to establish

1		probable cause that the school employee, contractor, or agent engaged in
2		sexual misconduct regarding a minor or student in violation of the law;
3	<u>(2)</u>	The school employee, contractor, or agent has been charged with, and
4		acquitted or otherwise exonerated of the alleged misconduct; or
5	<u>(3)</u>	The case or investigation remains open and there have been no charges
6		filed against, or indictment of, the school employee, contractor, or agent
7		within one year of the date on which the information was reported to a law
8		enforcement agency.
9	SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 15.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created	
10	and enacted as follows:	
11	Conviction of aiding and abetting sexual abuse - Penalty.	
12	Any individual who is a school district employee, contractor, or agent convicted of aiding	
13	and abetting sexual abuse as described in section 1 of this Act is guilty of a class B	

14 <u>misdemeanor.</u>
