- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-07-33 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the student information system.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-07-33 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 15.1-07-33. Student information system Exemption.
 - 1. Notwithstanding any other technology requirements imposed by the superintendent of public instruction, the information technology department, or the North Dakota educational technology council, each school district shall acquire PowerSchool-throughimplement the state student information system administered by the information technology department and use it as its principal student information system. Each school district shall use a state course code, assigned by the department of public instruction, to identify all local classes in PowerSchoolthe state student information system.
 - 2. The superintendent of public instruction may exempt a school district from having to acquireimplement and utilize PowerSchoolthe state student information system if the school district demonstrates that, in accordance with requirements of the bureau of Indian education, the district has acquired and is utilizing a student information system that is determined to be comparable by the superintendent.
