

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT
with House Amendments
ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2005**

Appropriations Committee

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the Indian affairs
2 commission; to provide an exemption; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the Indian affairs commission for the purpose of
7 defraying the expenses of the Indian affairs commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,
8 2021, and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:

15 **SECTION 2. EXEMPTION - LINE ITEM TRANSFERS - 2019-21 BIENNIUM.**

16 Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, the office of management and budget may transfer up to
17 \$15,000 of appropriation authority from the operating expenses line item to the salaries and
18 wages line item in section 1 of chapter 5 of the 2019 Session Laws as requested by the Indian
19 affairs commission.

20 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** Section 2 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
