1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of
2 environmental quality.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
7 other income, to the department of environmental quality for the purpose of defraying the
8 expenses of the department of environmental quality, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021,
9 and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:

20 **SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding
21 items approved by the sixty-sixth legislative assembly for the 2019-21 biennium:

1 **SECTION 3. ESTIMATED INCOME - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION**

2 **FUND.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$250,000
3 from the environment and rangeland protection fund. This amount includes \$50,000 for a grant
4 to the North Dakota stockmen's association environmental services program.

5 **SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - STATE FIRE AND TORNADO FUND.** The estimated
6 income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$882,249 from the state fire and
7 tornado fund for the boiler inspection program.

8 **SECTION 5. ESTIMATED INCOME - PETROLEUM TANK RELEASE COMPENSATION**

9 **FUND.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$297,217
10 from the petroleum tank release compensation fund for expenses related to the petroleum tank
11 release program.
