- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 62.1-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to manufactured firearms, accessories, and ammunition.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 62.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6 Firearms - Manufacture - Prohibition.

- 7 <u>1. A personal firearm, firearm accessory, or ammunition manufactured commercially or</u>
- 8 privately in the state and which remains within the state is not subject to federal law or
- 9 <u>federal regulation, including registration as those items are not subject to regulations</u>
- 10 related to interstate commerce. This section applies to a firearm, firearm accessory, or
- 11 <u>ammunition manufactured in the state from basic materials and which can be</u>
- 12 <u>manufactured without the inclusion of any significant parts imported from another</u>
- 13 <u>state.</u>
- 14 <u>2.</u> <u>Generic and insignificant parts that have other manufacturing or consumer product</u>
- 15 <u>applications are not firearms, firearm accessories, or ammunition, and importation into</u>
- 16 <u>the state and incorporation into a firearm, firearm accessory, or ammunition</u>
- 17 <u>manufactured in the state does not subject the firearm, firearm accessory, or</u>
- 18 ammunition to federal regulation. Unmachined steel and unshaped wood are not
- 19 <u>firearms, firearm accessories, or ammunition and are not subject to congressional</u>
- 20 <u>authority to regulate firearms, firearm accessories, and ammunition under interstate</u>
- 21 <u>commerce. The authority of congress to regulate basic materials does not include</u>
- 22 <u>authority to regulate firearms, firearm accessories, and ammunition made in the state</u>
- 23 from those materials.

- 1 <u>3.</u> Firearm accessories imported into the state from another state and which are subject
- 2 <u>to federal regulation as being in interstate commerce do not subject a firearm to</u>
- 3 <u>federal regulation under interstate commerce because the accessories are attached to</u>
- 4 <u>or used with a firearm in the state.</u>
