

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 2063

Page 1, line 2, after "trophy" insert "; to provide for a budget section report; and to provide a contingent appropriation"

Page 1, line 6, overstrike "**Nickel**" and insert immediately thereafter "**Football**"

Page 1, after line 6, insert:

"1. After being retired by the university of North Dakota and the North Dakota state university of agriculture and applied science, the state-owned nickel trophy must be displayed permanently in the heritage center.

2."

Page 1, line 9, overstrike "the nickel" and insert immediately thereafter "a state-owned"

Page 1, line 10, after "game" insert "beginning with the football game in the fall of 2023"

Page 1, line 10, overstrike "If the athletic director or president of either institution elects"

Page 1, line 11, overstrike "not to play for the nickel trophy, the nickel trophy must be"

Page 1, line 12, remove "acquired by the state historical society and become part of the state historical society's"

Page 1, line 13, remove "permanent collection"

Page 1, line 13, overstrike the period

Page 1, after line 13, insert:

"SECTION 2. CONTINGENT APPROPRIATION - REPORT TO BUDGET SECTION - FOOTBALL TROPHY. The university of North Dakota and North Dakota state university of agriculture and applied science shall present a report to the budget section before June 30, 2022, with a plan for how the universities will collaborate to design and create a state-owned trophy for purposes of section 15-10-62. If the budget section approves the plan for collaboration, there is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$9,900, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the university of North Dakota and North Dakota state university of agriculture and applied science for the purpose of designing and creating a state-owned trophy, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023. The funds appropriated under this section may be supplemented by other resources of the universities, provided the use of the other resources is not contrary to legislative appropriations."
