SB 2213 expands the property tax credit for disabled veterans.

Section 1 of SB 2213 expands the value of the home subject to the property tax credit that may be claimed by the qualified disabled veteran. The provisions of the bill allow the credit to be applied against the first \$11,250 of taxable valuation of the homestead owned and occupied by the qualified disabled veteran or the unremarried surviving spouse of the qualified deceased veteran.

If enacted, SB 2213 is expected to increase the cost of the disabled veterans property tax credit program by \$3.8 million in the 2021-23 biennium. The disabled veterans property tax credit is reimbursed to the counties by the state. Enactment of the bill will require a corresponding increase in appropriations to the Office of Tax Commissioner for the disabled veterans property tax credit program.
