SB 2220 removes the existing restriction on the dispensing of alcohol on Sunday mornings.

Sections 1 and 2 allow the dispensing of alcohol on Sunday - both on and off sale - subject to local ordinance from 8:00 AM to 12:00 noon by domestic wineries and distilleries. Section 3 allows alcohol to be dispensed in other licensed premises between 8:00 AM and 11:00 AM on Sunday.
