- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 15.1-21-17.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to interim assessment of students.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** Section 15.1-21-17.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and 6 enacted as follows:
- 6 <u>15.1-21-17.1. Interim assessment State-provided or state-approved list.</u>
- Each public school district shall administer annually to students in grades kindergarten
 through ten at least two assessments in mathematics and reading. In administering
 the assessment, a public school district shall use:
- 10 a. The state-provided interim assessment; or
- b. An interim assessment from a state-approved list created and maintained by the
 superintendent of public instruction.
- 13 2. The superintendent of public instruction shall contract with an interim assessment
 14 vendor to create a state-provided interim assessment and distribute the assessment to
 15 each public school district, at no charge to the districts, for the grade levels and
 16 subjects provided in subsection 1.
- 17 3. If a district chooses to use an assessment from the state-approved list, the district is
 18 responsible for the cost of administering the assessment.
- 4. To qualify as a state-provided or state-approved vendor of interim assessments, a
 vendor must share the assessment data electronically with the statewide longitudinal
 data system.
- 5. The superintendent shall adopt rules to develop the selection and approval criteria for
 a state-approved interim assessment vendor.
