5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 SECTION 1. Two new subsections to section 15.1-09-33 of the North Dakota Century Code
 7 are created and enacted as follows:
- 8 Authorize schools within the district to display the ten commandments with a display of
- 9 <u>other historical documents in the school and in a classroom.</u>

11 Authorize schools within the district to permit students to recite the pledge of

12 <u>allegiance.</u>

- 13 SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 14 and enacted as follows:

15 School board - Immunity from liability.

- 16 The superintendent of public instruction, school districts, schools, school boards and
- 17 individual school board members, governing boards and individual governing board members,
- 18 administrators, principals, teachers, and any other school district employed personnel are
- 19 immune from any liability for damages resulting from a school's decision to display the ten
- 20 commandments or permit students to recite the pledge of allegiance under section 1 of this Act.
