1 A BILL for an Act to authorize the department of public instruction to withhold state school aid-

- 2 for information technology project upgrades to the state automated reporting system and the
- 3 statewide longitudinal data system; to provide a statement of legislative intent; provide an
- 4 <u>appropriation to the department of public instruction for information technology project upgrades</u>
- 5 to the state automated reporting system and the statewide longitudinal data system and to
- 6 provide an effective date.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

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9 WITHHOLDING - LEGISLATIVE INTENT.

- 10 Integrated formula payments to school districts eligible to receive funding from the 11 federal elementary and secondary school emergency education relief fund must be-12 reduced by a one-time amount of \$88 per average daily membership based on 2021-13 fall enrollment to reimburse the department of public instruction for information 14 technology project upgrades to the state automated reporting system and the 15 statewide longitudinal data system. Funds must be withheld before April 1, 2022, and 16 must be deposited in the public instruction fund for information technology project 17 upgrades to the state automated reporting system and the statewide longitudinal data-18 system, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 19 2023. 20 2. It is the intent of the sixty seventh legislative assembly that the department of
- public instruction use federal elementary and secondary school emergency education
 relief funding appropriated to the department by the sixty seventh legislative assembly
 to reimburse eligible school districts for the amounts withheld under subsection 1 of
 - this section.

Sixty-seventh Legislative Assembly

1	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION - STATE
2	FISCAL RECOVERY FUND - ONE-TIME FUNDING. There is appropriated from federal funds
3	derived from the state fiscal recovery fund, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$10,000,000,
4	or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of public instruction for the
5	purpose of information technology project upgrades to the state automated reporting system
6	and the statewide longitudinal data system, for the period beginning with the effective date of
7	this Act and ending June 30, 2023. The funding provided in this section is a one-time funding
8	item.
9	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective on December 1, 2021.
