- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 57-38-30.3 of
- 2 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to an income tax deduction for retired law enforcement
- 3 personnel benefits; and to provide an effective date.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 57-38-30.3 of the North Dakota 6 Century Code is created and enacted as follows: 7 Reduced by the amount of retired law enforcement personnel benefits received 8 by a taxpaver as retired law enforcement personnel benefits who has served a 9 combined total of at least twenty years as a peace officer or has medically retired 10 from the taxpayer's duties as a peace officer with a medical certificate due to a 11 permanent mental or physical disability that rendered the taxpayer unable to 12 discharge the taxpayer's duties as a peace officer, but only to the extent the 13 amount was included in federal taxable income. For purposes of this subdivision: 14 (1) "Peace officer" means a public servant authorized by law or by a 15 government agency or branch of the United States, a state, or a political 16 subdivision of a state to enforce the law and to conduct or engage in 17 investigations of violations of the law. 18 <u>(2)</u> "Retired law enforcement personnel benefits" means retirement income 19 received by a taxpayer eligible to receive retirement income attributable to 20 the taxpayer's employment as a peace officer from a retirement plan 21 maintained by or through the employer from which the taxpayer retired as a 22 peace officer. 23 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after 24 December 31, 2022.
