- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 16.1-08.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to reports of expenditures made in support of or opposition to legislative
- 3 candidates; to amend and reenact subsection 7 of section 16.1-08.1-01; and to provide a
- 4 penalty.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 7 of section 16.1-08.1-01 of the North Dakota
- 7 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 7. "Expenditure categories" means the categories into which expenditures must be 9 grouped for reports under this chapter. The expenditure categories are:
- 10 a. Advertising by:
- 11 <u>— (1) Radio;</u>
- 12 <u>(2) Mail;</u>
- 13 <u>(3) <u>Television;</u></u>
- 14 (<u>4) Printed media; and</u>
- 15 <u>(5)</u> <u>Social media;</u>
- 16 b. Campaign loan repayment;
- 17 <u>c. Operations;</u>
- 18 d. Travel; and
- 19 <u>e. Miscellaneous.</u>
- 20 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 16.1-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 21 created and enacted as follows:

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1	Expendi	iture reports by multicandidate political committees.	
2	1. A multicandidate political committee required to file a report under section		
3	16.1-08.1-02.3 shall file expenditure reports under this section with the secretary of		
4	state. For each aggregated expenditure of five thousand dollars or more spent in		
5	support of or opposition to a member of the legislative assembly or a candidate for the		
6	office of state senator or state representative, the multicandidate political committee		
7	shall file a report including:		
8	<u>a.</u>	The aggregated amount expended name of the multicandidate committee;	
9	<u>b.</u>	The name of the member or candidate supported or opposed complete address of	
10		the multicandidate committee;	
11	C.	The name of the recipient of the expenditure;	
12	<u>e.d.</u>	Whether the expenditure was made in support of or opposition to the member or	
13		a candidate or candidates and the name of the candidate or candidates;	
14	<u> </u>	The amount of the expenditure;	
15	<u>d.f.</u>	The datecumulative total amount of the expenditure; and expenditures since the	
16		beginning of the calendar year which are required to be reported under this	
17		section;	
18	<u> </u>	<u>A general description of the items, services, or contributions for which the</u>	
19		expenditure was made, including the	
20	g.	The total of all expenditures made under each applicable expenditure category,	
21		and if advertising is an applicable expenditure category, whether the advertising	
22		was conducted via radio, mail, television, printed media, or social media; and	
23	h.	If applicable, whether the advertising expenditures were made in support of or	
24		opposition to a candidate or candidates and the name of the candidate or	
25		candidates.	
26	<u>2.</u> For	purposes of calculating the aggregated expenditure per member of the legislative	
27	ass	embly or candidate for the office of state senator or state representative under	
28	<u>sut</u>	osection 1, expenditures made in support of or opposition to multiple members or	
29	car	ndidates must be divided equally by the number of members or candidates	
30	<u>su</u> t	pported or opposed, and the resulting amount must be allocated to each of the	

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1		relevant members or candidates. The statement must delineate clearly the amount
2		expended in support of or opposition to each candidate.
3	<u>3.</u>	Reports under this section must be filed within forty-eight hours after the
4		multicandidate political committee makes the expenditure that, when aggregated with
5		other expenditures in support of or opposition to the member or candidate, exceeds is
6		five thousand dollars or more.
