1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the information

2 technology department; to provide a transfer; <u>and to provide an exemption</u>; and to provide for a

3 report.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 6 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 8 other income, to the information technology department for the purpose of defraying the 9 expenses of the information technology department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, 10 and ending June 30, 2025, as follows:

SECTION 3. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION. All federal funds received by the
information technology department in excess of those funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act
are appropriated to the information technology department for the biennium beginning July 1,
2023, and ending June 30, 2025.

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SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - TRANSFER - HEALTH INFORMATION

25 TECHNOLOGY PLANNING LOAN FUND TO ELECTRONIC HEALTH INFORMATION

26 **EXCHANGE FUND.** Notwithstanding section 6-09-43, the estimated income line item in

- 27 section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$3,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be
- 28 necessary, which the Bank of North Dakota shall transfer, as requested by the chief information
- 29 officer, from the health information technology planning loan fund to the electronic health
- 30 information exchange fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the health information

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1 technology office and the health information network during the biennium beginning July 1,

2 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.

3 SECTION 5. EXEMPTION - LINE ITEM TRANSFERS. Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, 4 the director of the office of management and budget shall make transfers of funds between line 5 items in section 1 of this Act for the information technology department as may be requested by 6 the chief information officer as determined necessary for the development and implementation 7 of information technology projects. The department shall notify the legislative council of any 8 transfers made pursuant to this section. 9 **SECTION 6. ESTIMATED INCOME - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS** 10 **FUND.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of 11 \$16,500,000\$15,000,000 from the strategic investment and improvements fund, of which 12 \$10,000,000 is for the enterprise digitization project. \$3,000,000 is for the call center 13 software upgrade project, and \$6,500,000\$5,000,000 is for the customer relationship 14 management program. 15 SECTION 7. ESTIMATED INCOME - FEDERAL STATE FISCAL RECOVERY FUND. The 16 estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$2,499,467\$3,499,467 17 from federal funds derived from the state fiscal recovery fund, of which \$2,499,467 is for the 18 capitol security software upgrade and fiber replacement project and \$1,000,000 is for the 19 universal vulnerability management project. 20 **SECTION 8. ESTIMATED INCOME - CHOICE READY DASHBOARD EXPANSION** 21 **PROJECT.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of 22 \$4,856,876 from the information technology department operating service fund for department 23 of public instruction-related projects, of which \$300,000 is for a choice ready dashboard 24 expansion project to allow schools to monitor student progress for graduation and report the 25 results to the department of public instruction. 26 SECTION 9. EXEMPTION - BROADBAND INFRASTRUCTURE GRANTS. The amount of 27 Of the \$45,000,000 appropriated from federal funds derived from the coronavirus capital 28 projects fund for the broadband infrastructure grants program in section 9 of chapter 548 of the 29 2021 Special Session Session Laws, \$18,500,000 is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and is 30 available for the program during the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 31 2025.

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1 SECTION 10. EXEMPTION - NORTH DAKOTA STOCKMEN'S ASSOCIATION

- 2 **BRANDING INSPECTION SYSTEM.** The amount of \$401,000 appropriated from federal funds
- 3 derived from the state fiscal recovery fund for the purpose of providing a grant to the North
- 4 Dakota stockmen's association for conversion of a paper-based brand inspection program to an
- 5 electronic system in subsection 23 of section 1 of chapter 550 of the 2021 Special Session
- 6 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and is available for the program during the
- 7 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.
