- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of
- 2 veterans' affairs; to provide an exemption; and to provide for a report.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds

5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state

treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and

other income, to the department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of defraying the expenses of

the department of veterans' affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending

9 June 30, 2025, as follows:

committees of the sixty-ninth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.

SECTION 3. EXEMPTION - POSTTRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER SERVICE DOG PROGRAM. The \$50,000 appropriated from the general fund for the posttraumatic stress disorder service dog program in section 1 of chapter 25 of the 2019 Session Laws and the \$50,000 appropriated from the general fund for the posttraumatic stress disorder service dog program in section 1 of chapter 53 of the 2021 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unspent funds from this program are available for the program during the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.

SECTION 4. EXEMPTION - FEDERAL STATE FISCAL RECOVERY FUND. The \$647,000 appropriated from the federal state fiscal recovery fund in subsections 32 and 33 of section 1 of chapter 550 of the 2021 Session Laws, of which \$500,000 was for a grant to assist in the construction of the Fisher house at the Fargo veterans' affairs medical center and \$147,000 was for improving and expanding veterans' medical transportation, is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unspent funds from these programs are available for the programs during the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.
