- 2 relating to the surveying process during eminent domain proceedings; and to declare an
- 3 emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 32-15-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 32-15-06. Entry for making surveys.
- 8 In all cases when land is required for public use, the person or corporation, or the person's
- 9 or corporation's agents, in charge of such the use may survey and locate the same, but it land
- 10 upon obtaining written consent from the landowner or by order of the court. The survey and
- 11 <u>location of the condemnor's project</u> must be located in the manner which will be compatible with
- 12 the greatest public benefit and the least private injury and subject to the provisions of section
- 13 32-15-21. Whoever is in charge of suchthe public use may enter upon the land and make
- examinations, surveys, and maps thereofof the land, and such the entry constitutes no does not
- 15 constitute a claim for relief in favor of the owner of the land except for injuries resulting from
- 16 negligence, wantonness, or malice.
- 17 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
