- 2 relating to domestic terrorism; to provide a penalty; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** Section 12.1-17-04.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and

5 enacted as follows:

- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>As used in this section:</u>
- 8 a. "Domestic terrorism" means an activity conducted within the geographical
 9 boundaries of the state which:
- 10(1)Is done in cooperation with any federally designated terrorist organization11that threatens or appears to threaten the sovereignty of the state or the12United States of America;
 - (2) Is a violation of criminal law; and

- (a) Involves violent acts or threats specifically intended to physically harm <u>human life and:</u>
