## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

## 4 SECTION 1. JUVENILE JUSTICE STUDY - JUVENILE DELINQUENCY OFFENSE

- **CODE REPORT.** During the 2023-24 interim, the legislative management, in collaboration with the commission on juvenile justice, shall study the criminal code to ensure equitable application to youths charged with juvenile delinquencies. The study must include consideration of the desirability and feasibility of a separate juvenile delinquency offense code, whether a separate and unique classification of criminal offenses for juveniles should be created, and which criminal
- offenses should receive a distinct classification for juvenile offenders, if any. In conducting the
- 11 study, the legislative management and the commission on juvenile justice may seek technical
- 12 assistance, as appropriate, from the council of state governments' justice center. The legislative
- 13 management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation
- 14 required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.
