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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-32 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

<u>Dyslexia voucher program - Report to legislative management.</u>

- 1. The superintendent of public instruction shall establish a dyslexia voucher program to

 assist in funding general educational needs related to dyslexia for individuals from age

 five to under age eighteen who have been identified as having dyslexia. The program

 may include funding for assistive technology, audio books or computer support for

 reading, language-generating devices, training and educational materials for parents,

 parenting education, language comprehension equipment, and tutors, including private

 tutors training in dyslexia interventions.
 - 2. The superintendent of public instruction shall adopt rules to address the management of the program and to establish the eligibility requirements and exclusions for the program.
- 3. The superintendent of public instruction shall report biennially, by September first of
 each even-numbered year, to the legislative management regarding the dyslexia
 voucher program.
