8 <u>Posting of grant lands prohibited.</u>

- 9 <u>Any grant lands leased for pasturage and meadow purposes must remain open to the</u>
- 10 public at all times. No lessee of any of the lands authorized to be leased under this chapter, nor-
- 11 <u>the lessee's heirs or assigns, may post the leased tract for purposes of prohibiting public</u>
- 12 <u>access.</u>

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - PUBLIC ACCESS TO SCHOOL

14 **TRUST LANDS.** During the 2023-24 interim, the legislative management shall consider

- 15 studying the impact of posting and restricting access to school trust lands during the big game
- 16 hunting seasons. The study must include a review of current law applied to the posting of school
- 17 trust lands. The study must include input from the department of trust lands and the game and
- 18 fish department. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations,
- 19 together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-ninth
- 20 legislative assembly.
