- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 23-01 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 32-12.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to studying vaccines and the
- 3 medical liability of a governmental entity.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 23-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Vaccine study - Liability liability.

- 1. The department of health and human services shall study and maintain records on the effects of any vaccine intended to develop an immune system response to SARS-CoV-2 and any mutation or viral fragments of SARS-CoV-2. The study must include research on individuals who died thirty days after receiving the vaccine.
- 2. If the department of health and human services promotes, markets, or advertises any messenger ribonucleic acid vaccine or any vaccine intended to develop an immune system response to SARS-CoV-2 and any mutation or viral fragments of SARS-CoV-2 as safe, the department shall cover the costs of treatment and diagnostics for any individual who suffers any physical injury due to receiving the vaccine.
- **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 32-12.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Medical liability of government entity.

- As used in this section, "medical product" means any product used to diagnose or manage SARS-CoV-2, any mutation or viral fragments of SARS-CoV-2, or a future disease, including any medical device, treatment, or drug.
 - 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a state agency, political subdivision, or any other governmental entity, may not require an individual to take, receive, or disclose

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- 1 whether the individual has taken or received a medical product unless the
- 2 <u>manufacturer of the medical product is liable for any death or serious injury caused by</u>
- 3 <u>the medical product.</u>
- 4 3. Subsection 2 does not apply to a public hospital.
