ı	A BILL for all Act to create and effact a flew section to chapter 1-05 of the North Dakota Century
2	Code, relating to establishing an annual day of awareness for fetal alcohol spectrum disorder; to

- 3 amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 25-01.2-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 4 relating to fetal alcohol spectrum disorder; and to repeal section 50-06-32 of the North Dakota
- 5 Century Code, relating to the autism spectrum disorder task force.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
 and enacted as follows:
- 9 <u>Fetal alcohol spectrum disorder awareness day.</u>
- To celebrate the life of all affected by fetal alcohol spectrum disorder, reaffirm the dignity
- and value of every human being, and to create awareness of the number of people affected by
- the disorder, the ninth day of September of each year is designated and established as fetal
- 13 alcohol spectrum disorder awareness day for the state of North Dakota.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 25-01.2-01 of the North Dakota
 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 3. "Developmental disability" means a severe, chronic disability of an individual which:
 - a. Is attributable to a mental or physical impairment or combination of mental and physical impairments, including Down syndrome and fetal alcohol spectrum disorders, including fetal alcohol syndrome, partial fetal alcohol syndrome, and alcohol-related neurodevelopmental disorder;
- b. Is manifested before the individual attains age twenty-two;
- c. Is likely to continue indefinitely;
- d. Results in substantial functional limitations in three or more of the following areas
 of major life activity:
