## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

## 4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - LAW ENFORCEMENT STAFFING

AND EQUIPMENT. During the 2023-24 interim, the legislative management shall study the
equipment and staffing needs of law enforcement departments in the state. The study must
include assessing the:

- 8 1. Specific and unique challenges faced by certain regions or communities, such as a
- 9 large population of high-risk offenders or offenders under some form of supervision or
  10 monitoring program;
- Types of technologies available to law enforcement for the purpose of supervising or
   monitoring offenders; and
- 13 3. Costs associated with purchase, implementation, and maintenance of those
- 14 technologies available to law enforcement for supervising or monitoring offenders.
- 15 The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with
- 16 any legislation necessary to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-ninth legislative
- 17 assembly.
