- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 26.1 36 12.7 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to freedom of choice for health care services.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** Section 26.1-36-12.7 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and

5 enacted as follows:

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6 <u>26.1-36-12.7. Freedom of choice for health care services.</u>

- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>As used in this section:</u>
- 8 a. "Health care provider" includes an individual licensed under chapters 43-05, 43-06, 43-12.1 as a registered nurse or as an advanced practice registered
 10 nurse, 43-13, 43-15, 43-17, 43-26.1, 43-28, 43-32, 43-37, 43-40, 43-41, 43-42, 43-44, 43-45, 43-47, 43-58, or 43-60.
 12 b. "Integrated delivery network" means a system of health care providers and
 - facilities which offer both health care services and policies.
- <u>c.</u> <u>"Policy" means a health insurance policy, contract, or evidence of coverage on a</u>
 <u>group, individual, blanket, franchise, or association basis.</u>
- 16 <u>2.</u> <u>A health insurer, including the Medicaid program, which is part of an integrated</u>
- 17 <u>delivery network or a policy directly affiliated with or administered for a health care</u>
- 18 provider may not obstruct patient choice by excluding a health care provider licensed
- 19 <u>under the laws of this state from participating on the health insurer's panel of providers</u>
- 20 <u>if the provider is located within the geographic coverage area of the health benefit plan</u>
- 21 and is willing and fully qualified to meet the terms and conditions of participation, as
- 22 <u>established by the health insurer.</u>
