3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES - STANDARD

5 FRAMEWORK OF SERVICES FOR CHILD VICTIMS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING - REPORT

6 TO LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT.

- During the 2023-24 interim, the department of health and human services shall study and implement, in collaboration with other stakeholders, a standard framework for youth services for children impacted or potentially impacted by human trafficking, which includes residential treatment.
 The department of health and human services shall collaborate with other stakeholders, including the child and family services section of the department of
- health and human services, the office of the attorney general, and the humantrafficking task force.
- Before July 1, 2024, the department of health and human services shall report its
 findings and recommendations to the legislative management.
