- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 1-01-49 and subsection 7 of section 51-35-01 of
- 2 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of female, male, sex, and scrap metal
- 3 dealer.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 1-01-49 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 1-01-49. Other general definitions.
- 8 As used in this code, unless the context otherwise requires <u>or unless otherwise defined</u>:
- 9 1. "Depose" includes every mode of written statement under oath or affirmation.
- 10 2. "Executor" includes administrator and "administrator" includes executor.
- 11 3. <u>"Female" means a girl, woman, or an individual whose biological reproductive system</u>
- 12 <u>is developed to produce ova.</u>
- 13 <u>4.</u> "Individual" means a human being.
- 14 <u>5.</u> "Male" means a boy, man, or an individual whose biological reproductive system is
   developed to produce sperm.
- 16 4.6. "Oath" includes "affirmation".
- 17 <u>5.7.</u> "Organization" includes a foreign or domestic association, business trust, corporation,
- enterprise, estate, joint venture, limited liability company, limited liability partnership,
- 19 limited partnership, partnership, trust, or any legal or commercial entity.
- 20 6.8. "Partnership" includes a limited liability partnership registered under chapter 45-22.
- 21 7.9. "Penitentiary" includes any affiliated facilities.
- 22 8-10. "Person" means an individual, organization, government, political subdivision, or
- 23 government agency or instrumentality.

1 "Personal property" includes money, goods, chattels, things in action, and evidences <del>9.</del>11. 2 of debt. 3 <del>10.</del>12. "Preceding" and "following" when used by way of reference to a chapter or other part 4 of a statute means the next preceding or next following chapter or other part. 5 <del>11.</del>13. "Primary sector business" means an individual, corporation, limited liability company, 6 partnership, or association certified by the department of commerce division of 7 economic development and finance which through the employment of knowledge or 8 labor adds value to a product, process, or service which results in the creation of new 9 wealth. 10 For purposes of this subsection, "new wealth" means revenues generated by a 11 business in this state through the sale of products or services to: 12 Customers outside of this state; or a. 13 Customers in this state if the products or services were previously unavailable or b. 14 difficult to obtain from a business in this state. 15 <del>12.</del>14. "Process" means a writ or summons issued in the course of judicial proceedings. 16 <del>13.</del>15. "Property" includes property, real and personal. 17 <del>14.</del>16. "Real property" shall be coextensive with lands, tenements, and hereditaments. 18 <del>15.</del>17. "Rule" includes regulation. 19 <del>16.</del>18. "Sex" means the biological state of being male or female, based on the individual's 20 nonambiguous sex organs, chromosomes, or endogenous hormone profiles at birth. 21 <u>19.</u> "Signature" or "subscription" includes "mark" when the person cannot write, the 22 person's name being written near it and written by a person who writes that person's 23 own name as a witness. 24 <del>17.</del>20. "State" when applied to the different parts of the United States, includes the District of 25 Columbia and the territories. 26 <del>18.</del>21. "Testify" includes every mode of oral statement under oath or affirmation. 27 <del>19.</del>22. "United States" includes the District of Columbia and the territories. 28 <del>20.</del>23. "Will" includes codicils. 29 <del>21.</del>24. "Writ" means an order or precept in writing, issued in the name of the state or of a 30 court or judicial officer.

- 1 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 7 of section 51-35-01 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7. "Scrap metal dealer" means a person, as defined in subsection 8 of section 1-01-49,
- 4 engaged in the business of purchasing, selling, trading, or bartering scrap metal, and
- 5 includes all employees of the scrap metal dealer.
