2	environmental impacts of oil, hydraulic fracturing sand, and hydraulic fracturing wastewater
3	spills on water quality, vegetation, soil, and all species of domestic and wild animals, including
4	insects, along State Highways 22, 23, and 37 within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Berthold
5	Reservation.
6	WHEREAS, oil, hydraulic fracturing sand, and hydraulic fracturing wastewater spills have
7	occurred along State Highways 22, 23, and 37 within the exterior boundaries of the Fort
8	Berthold Reservation; and
9	WHEREAS, oil, hydraulic fracturing sand, and hydraulic fracturing wastewater spills may
10	result in soil, surface water, and ground water contamination, which may have a negative
11	impact on water quality, vegetation, soil, and animals; and
12	WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to review potential environmental impacts associated
13	with oil, hydraulic fracturing sand, and hydraulic fracturing wastewater spills along State
14	Highways 22, 23, and 37 within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Berthold Reservation;
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
16	NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
17	That the Legislative Management consider studying the environmental impacts of oil,
18	hydraulic fracturing sand, and hydraulic fracturing wastewater spills on water quality, vegetation,
19	soil, and all species of domestic and wild animals, including insects, along State Highways 22,
20	23, and 37 within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Berthold Reservation; and
