- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 61-15 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to wild and scenic river designations.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 61-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 5 and enacted as follows: 6 Wild and scenic rivers. 7 Before a political subdivision engages in meetings with federal agencies to have any 8 waterbody in the state designated a wild, scenic, or recreational river under the Wild 9 and Scenic Rivers Act [16 U.S.C. 1271, et seq.] the political subdivision must notify 10 the: 11 <u>a.</u> Director of department of water resources; 12 Director of department of environmental quality; <u>b.</u> 13 Director of game and fish; <u>C.</u> 14 d. Director of parks and recreation; and 15 The water resource board of any water resource district that would be impacted: <u>e.</u> 16 Director of department of land trust; 17 Director of department of mineral resources; a. 18 h. The county commission of any county impacted; 19 The legislators of any district impacted; and
  - 2. Any written communications between the political subdivision and federal agencies regarding such designation must be copied to the list in subsection 1.

3. The county commission shall hold a public hearing regarding the potential designation.
