We write to you today in enthusiastic support of HB 1532, the educational reimbursement bill.

Three of our children attend Bishop Ryan Catholic School in Minot. It is a choice we didn't know we would be making until we enrolled our oldest at Bishop Ryan's Little Lions preschool. Once we experienced how amazing the educational experience was at Bishop Ryan, we knew there was no way we could send our children to the public schools in Minot. This is not to say that the public school system is not important or necessary, <u>but it is not for us</u>. We choose to have our children in an environment where they are challenged with a different (and in our mind, superior) type of educational model than exists in the public school system in Minot.
