In my opinion, the financial burden the current legislation on tournaments and tournament fees has placed on tournaments that are held within our state is far too restrictive. The result has been that the major tournament organizations have chosen to hold their events in other surrounding states that have much less restrictive fee structures. The loss of tournaments in our state affects our local communities with loss of tourism revenue. It also affects me personally by reducing the number of events available for me to participate in each year. Without major tournament circuits, there are virtually no other avenues to build yourself and your brand for building a professional fishing career.

Furthermore, there is a uprising of young anglers in the country, fishing high school and college fishing tournaments, and turning angling into a full time career. We need to pave a path in this state that allows our own children to have these types of opportunities as them become available.
