Minutes:

VICE CHAIRMAN MICKELSON OPENED THE HEARING ON HCR 3076; A BILL DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO STUDY THE PROVISION OF AIR SERVICE IN THIS STATE.

REPRESENTATIVE KATHY HAWKEN, Dist. 46, introduced HCR 3076. She said that it was heard in Judiciary Committee and the idea of the resolution is to review the dual system that is currently working in the state. She pointed out that even if you are innocent in a criminal case, it doesn't leave your record.

REP. MAHONEY asked Rep. Hawken if she was aware that this had already been looked at several years ago. He also noted a double jeopardy case that came up recently much like this.

REP. HAWKEN said she was aware of the bill being proposed last session, but the changes still need to be made. The record keeping needs to be rectified as you can have a DUI on your record and have it off in five years if there are no further violations.

REP. JENSEN questioned the language that states "apply in the case of a DUI."

REP. MAHONEY pointed out clarification that section 39-08-01 is where that language comes

in. It could be a bit more specific in that regard.

REP. MEYER asked if someone loses their license due to a DUI, how does the work permit operate?

REP. MAHONEY further pointed out that after the hearing, the guilty party must turn in their license and are not eligible for a work permit for 30 days.

REPRESENTATIVE ANDREW MARAGOS, Dist. 3, testified in support of HCR 3076. He spoke on behalf of former State Representative William Kretchmar who could not attend the hearing. He noted that it was in the best interest of the state to take another look at this even thought it has been presented before. He urged a Do Pass vote.

REP. MAHONEY asked if it really is a duplication of proceedings?

REP. MARAGOS said that something is not right from the fairness standpoint. It definitely warrants another chance.

VICE CHAIRMAN MICKELSON CLOSED THE HEARING ON HCR 3076. GENERAL DISCUSSION TOOK PLACE. REPS. MAHONEY, MEYER, AND SCHMIDT PARTICIPATED.
