Madam Chairman, members of the Committee, my name is Alex C. Schweitzer and I am the Superintendent of the North Dakota State Hospital.

I am here to support the Department of Human Services request to convey certain land in Stutsman County, as described in Senate Bill 2157, to the City of Jamestown, North Dakota at a price determined by the Department of Human Services.

This conveyance involves the sale and easement of 3.3 acres of land located in Section 5, Homer Township, Stutsman County, North Dakota. This tract of land is located south of what was the Interstate 94 right of way and between two tracts of land acquired by the City from the State of North Dakota on December 21, 1995. (See Attachment 1)

Currently this property is of no use to the State Hospital or ever will be and we are presently incurring the costs of spraying the land for noxious weeds. The property will be utilized by the city for roadway and tree planting purposes.

I am also passing out an amendment for your review as the legal description contained in the bill is incorrect. This amendment contains the correct legal description.

I would ask for your support of Senate Bill 2157, and I would be glad to answer any questions.

TESTIMONY BY DARRELL HOURNBUCKLE ASSISTANT CITY ENGINEER, JAMESTOWN ND

Madam Chairman and members of the committee, my name is Darrell Hournbuckle., I am the Assistant City Engineer of Jamestown North Dakota. I am here to testify in support of this bill.

The 1995 legislature approved a bill to convey land in Section 5 south east of the City of Jamestown labeled Auditors lot 5-2 and 5-3 on the attached exhibit 1. This land was subsequently purchased by the City of Jamestown from the Department of Human Services.

At the time the above land was conveyed to the City of Jamestown neither the Department of Human Services nor the City realized that the State owed the 100' strip between these parcels.

Since that time the City of Jamestown has begun development of the two parcels and begin investigating the ownership of the land between them. The City intends to construct a connecting gravel road between the parcels


The strip of land as it currently stands is not accessible to the Department of Human Services except directly from the Interstate Right of Way. The approval of this bill with the amendment would allow the City to develop easier the two parcels previously conveyed.

I am here to support the Department of Human Services request to convey certain land in Stutsman County, as described in Senate Bill 2157, to the City of Jamestown, North Dakota at a price determined by the Department of Human Services.

This conveyance involves the sale and easement of 3.3 acres of land located in Section 5, Homer Township, Stutsman County, North Dakota. This tract of land is located south of what was the Interstate 94 right of way and between two tracts of land acquired by the City from the State of North Dakota on December 21, 1995. (See Attachment 1). The fiscal note indicates an estimated value of \$300 per acre for the property.

Currently this property is of no use to the State Hospital or ever will be and we are presently incurring the costs of spraying the land for noxious weeds. The property will be utilized by the city for roadway and tree planting purposes.
