Senator Mutch opened the hearing on SB2302. All senators were present.

Senator Solberg introduced the bill. Senator Heitkamp asked him if this piece of legislation would only apply to policies that weren't replacement policies. Senator Solberg said that this would apply to all policies. Senator Heitkamp said that he agrees with Senator Solberg but that he was wondering if it would be to broad of a stroke.

Kent Olsen, Executive director of the PI in North Dakota, testified in opposition to SB2286. Said that they had some questions with line 5, dealing with personal property. They consider personal property to be household goods, rings, golf clubs, some farm equipment. They also had some questions about line 10. They said that they are not looking at this as commission

and that they are looking at it from a consumers point of view. Senator Heitkamp asked him if there was some way that both sides could agree. He did not believe that that would be illegal.

Tom Smith testified in the same standing that Kent Olsen testified in. He said that unless the bill was amended he to would have to be opposed to this legislation.

Senator Sand closed the hearing on SB2302.

Senator Sand motioned for a do not pass committee recommendation on SB2302. Senator Krebsbach seconded his motion. The motion carried with a 6-1-0 vote.
