Minutes:

Senator TIM MATHERN, District 11, testified that the resolution deals with coordination of planning and budgeting between the Department of Human Services and County Social Services. Both state and county participation is required for the delivery of services. This resolution asked that a complete study be done to determine how those two entities can work together. He asked for the committee's support.

Ms. MITCHELL SAX testified that the resolution was a compromise to what was studied during the interim session on consolidation and coordination of services being delivered by county social services in cooperation with North Dakota Department of Human Services. Ms. SAX feels that the counties are already working well with the state. This resolution asks that the counties continue to work in cooperation.

With no OPPOSITION the hearing was closed on SCR4002.

COMMITTEE DISCUSSION

Rep. WILLIAM DEVLIN said that he resented the implication of the resolution that counties haven't been cooperating. There has been cooperation going on with shared services for fifteen years. Interim studies takes time for counties and it costs them.
