The meeting was called to order. All committee members present. Hearing was opened on SB 2443 relating to pre-need funeral contracts.

SENATOR DAVID O'CONNELL, District 6, sponsor of the bill. I understand a similar bill was presented to this committee and was acted on. I leave it to the discretion of the committee to give this one a decent burial.

SENATOR KLEIN: The other bill mentioned revocable/irrevocable trusts.

SENATOR D. MATHERN: This one mentions the deceased's marital status and makes no mention of the 45 day cooling off period.

No opposing testimony. Hearing concluded.

SENATOR ESPEGARD: Move do pass.

SENATOR KREBSBACH: Second. Roll call vote: 7 yes; 0 no. Motion carried.

Senator Tollefson: But there would be a legal connotation to that.

Senator Tollefson: Motion to accede to House amendments. **Senator Krebsbach:** Second.
