The meeting was called to order. All committee members present. Hearing was opened on SCR 4024 urging Congress to eliminate the Social Security disability insurance offset and supplemental security insurance offset for recipients of workers' compensation benefits.

DAVID KEMNITZ, President AFLCIO, if the Bureau doesn't offset Social Security disability, the federal will. We are asking Congress to stop Social Security from doing that, if they do then we can get Workers' Comp to do it too. Urge do pass.

SEBALD VETTER, C.A.R.E., in favor. With rising costs injured workers should be entitled to the elimination of that offset.

RENEE PFENNING, ND B&CTC, in favor. Workers' Compensation does the offset because if done by Social Security they would take more. I favor the elimination of the offset.


